The Murals

The State of Washington sponsored eighty statewide projects to observe Washington's year-long Centennial Celebration.

In Grays Harbor, the celebration was kicked off in Aberdeen with the dedication of an initial four murals on November 11, 1988. Only one of which remains today – "The History of Transportation" at the Transit Center, by Jenny Fisher (restored in 2012). By the end of the celebration, there were forty murals in Grays Harbor, ten of which were in Aberdeen. Today, five of those ten still remain.


